1) **Word Study:** *Be sure to use the sentence in context and to write the word in color.*

Variable (n) - a quantity that can change (vary) or take on different values. In math, represented as symbols or letters

Linear (adj) anything that is a line or like a line

Cease (v) - to stop; discontinue

Contribute (v) - to give (money, time, knowledge, assistance, etc.) to a common supply, fund, etc., as for charitable purposes

Descendant- (n) - an offspring, of a certain ancestor, family, group, etc.

Exemplary (adj): perfect, worth imitating

Oppression (n): harsh or unjust rule or domination

Ruthlessly (adv): cruelly, in a harsh or merciless manner

Submissive (adv): in a humble and obedient manner

Insidious (adj): sly, treacherous, not readily recognized as dangerous

Write the definition of the prefix and suffix. Write the three words that follow the definition, and use one word per prefix/ suffix in a sentence that allows you to understand the word's meaning.

Con- (prefix) – with, jointly, completely (conspirator, converge, content)

-ant (suffix) – serving in the capacity of (applicant, contestant, tenant)
