1) Word Study: ON the FRONT, write the word in color.

On the BACK, write the definition And a sentence that helps a reader understand its meaning through reading the sentence.

Missionary (noun) - a person sent by a church into an area to carry on evangelism or other activities, as educational or hospital work.

Reparation (noun) - compensation in money, material, labor, etc., payable by a defeated country to another country or to an individual for loss suffered during or as a result of war

Bittersweet (adj) - both pleasant and painful or regretful

Obstinate (adj) - firmly or stubbornly adhering to one's purpose, opinion, etc.; not yielding to argument, persuasion, or entreaty

Ingenious (adj) - cleverly inventive or resourceful

Demonstrative (adj) - characterized by or given to open exhibition or expression of one's emotions, attitudes, etc., esp. of love or affection

Initiative (noun) - an introductory act or step; leading action

Furlough (noun) - a vacation or leave of absence

Retort (noun) - a severe, incisive, or witty reply, esp. one that counters a first speaker's statement, argument, etc.

Lavish (verb) - to expend or give in great amounts or without limit

On the FRONT of the flashcard, write the prefix or suffix. On the BACK, write the three words that follow the definition, and use one word per prefix/ suffix in a sentence that allows you to understand the word's meaning.

Re- (prefix) – again, back (repeat, recede, regress)

-ive (suffix) – like (talkative, creative, supportive)
