Ir - not or the opposite of (irregular, irreplaceable, irreverent)

Ex - out or out of (exhale, export, expulsion)

Suffixes:

-ic- having to do with (dramatic, allergic, metallic)

-ate- to become or to cause to become or have (consolidate, ventilate, activate)

-ology a discipline of study (biology, astrology, dermatology) -
